

Preventive Services

The following is a list of preventive services that PHP has determined meet, and in some cases exceed, the requirements and recommendations issued by the Affordable Care Act (ACA).

The ACA requires that non-grandfathered health plans cover preventive care services with no cost sharing. These services must be provided by an in-network health care provider and billed appropriately as a preventive service. This list is subject to change.*

Adults

- Abdominal aortic aneurysm (AAA) screening
- Alcohol/substance misuse screening and behavioral counseling
- Annual physical
- Cardiovascular screening (includes blood pressure and labs)
- Colorectal cancer screening
- Depression screening
- Diabetes screening
- Infectious and sexually transmitted disease screenings:
 - Chlamydia
 - HIV/AIDS
 - Gonorrhea
 - Human papillomavirus (HPV)
 - Hepatitis B
 - Syphilis
 - Hepatitis C
- Lung cancer screening
- Nutritional counseling
- Obesity screening and counseling
- Prostate cancer screening
- Skin cancer behavioral counseling
- Tobacco use counseling
- Tuberculosis (TB) testing

Children (newborn to age 18)

- Developmental screening
- Hearing screening
- Hypothyroidism screening
- Lead screening
- Newborn metabolic screening
- Oral health
- PKU screening
- Sickle cell screening
- Vision screening

Women's Health & Pregnancy

- Asymptomatic bacteriuria in pregnant women, screening
- Breast cancer screening
 - BRCA genetic counseling
 - BRCA genetic mutation testing
 - Mammography
 - Risk reduction of primary breast cancer
- Domestic violence screening/counseling
- Gynecological exam: cervical cancer screening
- Osteoporosis screening: bone density study
- Bone health
- Pregnancy
 - Anemia screening
 - Breastfeeding counseling
 - Breast pump
 - Labs for pre- and post-natal care and delivery
- Female sterilization procedures

**Non-Grandfathered – a plan effective after the Affordable Care Act (ACA) was signed on March 23, 2010, or a plan that existed before the ACA, but lost its grandfathered status at renewal.*
